ELEMENTARY PIANO

PIANO BEGINNER TO GRADE 1

SKILLS

In introductory piano learning, the skills developed include:

- Developing finger strength.
- Playing a melodic line.
- Understanding soft and loud.

PIANO REQUIREMENTS

To develop these skills, a practice instrument should have:

- Full sized, weighted piano keys.
- The ability to play with variations in soft and loud.
- Hold tune and be comfortable and enjoyable for the student to play.

FAQ

Can I buy a cheap piano on ebay to start?

Rather than discourage your child with an instrument that is hard to play and offers no skill development, teachers would much prefer you to buy a quality digital piano with weighted keys (Bernies Music has packages around \$900) or a good keyboard for \$3-500 which stays in tune and is comfortable and encouraging to play.

Tips For Success:

- Choose a daily practice time to fit your child's energy levels.
- Make it comfortable and easy for your child to practice; a quality instrument, with a seat at the right height, in tune and ready to play, will inspire happy practice!
- Get involved in practice; ask your child to play while you prepare dinner, and say "I like hearing you play!"
- Create a rewards chart for practice, with stickers, a treat or a small book at the end of each week or month goal. Five minutes a day is a great start, and increase when ready.
- Plan to learn for one year. If you've lined up a good teacher (www.vmta.org.au), a quality practice instrument, and plenty of encouragement at home, your chances of success are high!

PIANO GRADES 1 TO 4

SKILLS

The developing piano student will learn:

- To play with control of the hands for changes in volume and timing.
- To play with articulation.
- Play scales and songs with confidence and sound variation, especially in exams and performances.

PIANO REQUIREMENTS

To develop these skills, a practice instrument should have:

- Volume change; responding with sounds from soft to loud.
- Expression; the ability to produce warm rounded sounds when played gently, and bright brassy sounds when keys are struck with force.
- Quality action mechanism which allows the pianist to play quickly and accurately.

Suggested instruments below meet these requirements.

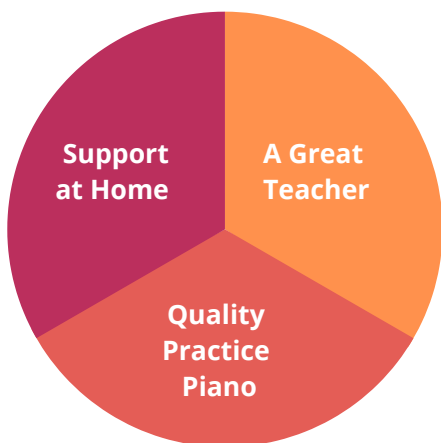
